1. All matters, on change of roster, shall stand released and shall be posted before the Bench/s as per roster, except matters which are reserved for judgment or under the caption 'CAV' or the matters which are part-heard.
2. First Appeals (other than Land Acquisition Appeals) exceeding valuation of Rs.25 lakhs, including CMAs, shall be posted before Division Bench as per roster.
3. The matters assigned to a Hon'ble Judge while sitting single by the Hon'ble the Chief Justice (except the matters allotted for Third Judge reference or Election Petitions) shall stand released, when the said Hon'ble Judge is assigned to preside over a Division bench or as the 2nd member of the Division Bench, and shall be posted before the Hon'ble Judge assigned to hear that category of matters.
4. When the recused matter is directed to be posted before other Bench by the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, on change of the roster and, if it is not part-heard, it shall be posted before the Judge assigned to hear that category of matters, if such Judge is different from the one who recused the matter.
5. Review Petitions and for being mentioned petitions shall be posted before the Hon'ble single Judge against whose order the review petition/for being mentioned petition is filed, and if the said Hon'ble Judge ceases to be a Judge of this High Court, the same may be posted before the Hon'ble Judge who is assigned to hear that category of case. All other interlocutory applications shall be posted, as per roster.
6. Matters may be assigned to any Bench under daily orders of Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
7. Urgent mentions, if any, including Lunch Motions pertaining to the provisions of all Division Benches shall be made before Division Bench-I.
8. Urgent mentions, if any, including Lunch Motions pertaining to the provisions of Single Benches shall be made before the respective Hon'ble Judges dealing with such matters of 'admission' except all Writ Petitions (Service Matters), Appeal Suits, Second Appeals, Civil Revision Petitions, Criminal Revision Cases and Criminal Petitions seeking quashment of Charge sheets and FIRs.
9. Urgent mentions, if any, including Lunch Motions pertaining to Criminal Revision Cases may be moved before the Hon'ble Sri **Justice C.Praveen Kumar**.
10. Urgent mentions, if any, including Lunch Motions pertaining to Appeal Suits and Second Appeals may be moved before the Hon'ble Sri **Justice U.Durga Prasad Rao**.
11. Urgent mentions, if any, including Lunch Motions pertaining to Civil Revision Petitions (CRPs) may be moved before the Hon'ble Sri **Justice M.Satyanarayana Murthy**.
12. Urgent mentions, if any, including Lunch Motions pertaining to Criminal Petitions seeking Quashment of Charge sheet and FIRs may be moved before the Hon'ble Ms. **Justice J.Uma Devi**.
13. Urgent mentions, if any, including Lunch Motions pertaining to All Writ Petitions (Service matters) may be moved before the Hon'ble Smt. **Justice T.Rajani**.
14. If, for any reason, DB-I is not functioning, the urgent mentions, if any, may be made before DB-II
15. If, for any reason, DB-II/DB-III /DB-IV is not functioning, all the cases assigned to that DB shall be listed before DB-III, DB-IV and DB-II respectively.
16. On Thursday, Final hearing cases from the weekly cause list shall be taken up by all the Division Benches and Single Benches, in addition to urgent motion, fresh matters and court fixed date cases.
17. The Hon'ble Judges sitting in Division Benches II,III & IV will sit single daily at 2:15 PM and take up the matters assigned to their Lordships.
